Lieven De Boeck currently has a show at Extra City in Antwerp until October 25, and has an artist's book of the same title 'Public Space, l.e.t.t.e.r.s.' that will be launched October 20, 2009 at Künstlerhaus Büchsenhausen

Nayda Callazo-Lorrens will be exhibiting in Gestures: The Mattress Factory in Pittsburgh, PA July-January. She is currently exhibiting (August-January) at Museo de Arte de Puerto Rico with Human Geography - Images from the 21st Century. In addition, she is in Transfer Lounge in Pittsburgh, October-November, Forja Arte Contemporaneo, Valencia, Spain, September-October and, Optica Festival (video) in various venues in Bolivia, Argentina, Spain, and France Aug-Oct 2009.

Gonzalo Fuenmayor will be in Bogota next October 13th -27th participating at ARTBO 2009 with Galeria Mundo and ARTECAMARA. His work was also selected to participate in Salon Nacional de Artistas, Region Caribe to be held in Cartagena this December, showing new work exploring the relationship between identity and nationality throughout the city.
